UNION PROMISES

It is important you know that, <u>by law</u>, the union can promise virtually anything, specifically because **it <u>is</u> not "a party capable of carrying out the promise".** The only way for the union to obtain some of the things it has been promising to get from the hospital is **if the hospital agrees**.

The hospital <u>can</u> deliver on its promises, and for that reason, the law prevents the hospital from making promises about such things as future wages, raises, bonuses, benefits, and policy or working condition improvements. All the hospital may say are things like "we will work hard to maintain competitive pay and benefits for our staff" or "we hear you" because saying "we will fix that" would be an illegal promise because the hospital IS "a party capable of carrying out the promise."

The union has been making many promises similar to the ones below – the law allows someone to make promises if they are NOT "a party capable of carrying out the promise." Before voting, **ask the union to put its guarantees in writing** and put its assets behind that promise!
