The sooner PASNAP knows that the majority of Reading Hospital nurses wish to remain independent of a third party, the sooner we can all return our focus to providing compassionate care to our community.



Don't sign a petition

If you aren't positive that unionization is the right choice for Reading Hospital nurses, do not sign a petition. This is a legally binding document. If you wish to rescind your signature, please email us—we can help!

Get the FACTS

Don't just take our word for information regarding unionization. While we have tried to simplify the research process by providing information for you, we encourage you to verify the information provided. Ask questions. Do your own research.

Get promises in writing!

Before you sign a petition, ask for all information in writing. If what the union is promising is true, the answer should be "Sure, no problem!"
