

Sanders SuperPAC, the New York Times reported, at the end of January that ‘more super PAC money has been spent so far in express support of Mr. Sanders than for either of his Democratic rivals, including Hillary Clinton, according to Federal Election Commission records.’”

Where is that money coming from?

“Much of that money comes from labor groups, in particular, the National Nurses Union, whose political division had spent more than half a million dollars on Sanders by last December, even while insisting that their support is distinct from big-money support by true super PACs,” according to Suderman.

As for Trump, Ben Schreckinger wrote for Politico.com in October that “the majority of his campaign funding comes from donors. This quarter, the campaign received 73,942 “unsolicited donations”

totaling about \$2.7 million.
