Update from Labor Board Hearing - Vote Coming Soon!

Einstein nurses filed with a majority at the Hospital for an election with the National Labor Relations Board. Instead of simply honoring the nurses' decision and coming to a reasonable agreement over the times, date, and location of the election, the Hospital Management has done everything it could to delay the vote by forcing three full days of hearings at the Labor Board and asking the Board for even further delay in setting the date of the election.

Why is the Hospital trying to delay the vote? — They know that if an election were held today at the main hospital, we would win.

Instead of agreeing to a fair vote, they are trying to dilute the voting pool by including nurses from outside of the city, nurses who have not had a chance to be informed about the unionization process, and what being union means for nurses and their patients.

Their strategy is transparent, and it's not going to work. We expect the Board to issue a ruling and set a date for an election by early next week. The election will likely be held within a week following that ruling, so we can look forward to having an election late next week or the following week.

After this election, nurses from other Einstein locations will be welcome to join the union.
